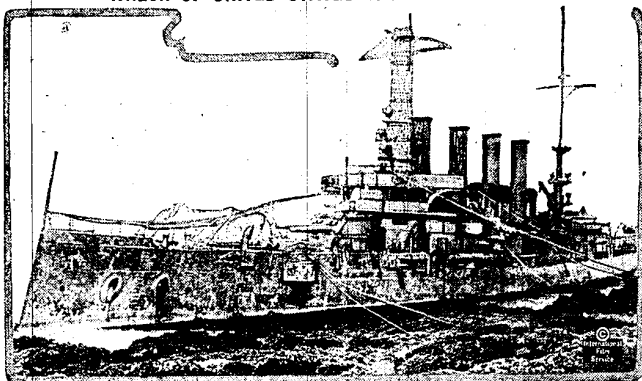

Tool-Making Peoples.

Are Anglo-Saxons conceded about their pre-eminence in matters of machinery? A book, "English and American Tool Builders," by Prof. J. W. Roe of Yale, answers the question thus: "Practically all the creative work in tool building has been done in England and America. . . . The French have shown an aptitude for refinements and ingenious novelties. . . . The Swiss are clever artisans, but have excelled in personal skill. . . . Germany has developed splendid mechanics, but the principal machine tools had taken shape before 1870, when the empire began. The history of English and American tool building, therefore, covers substantially the entire history of the art."

To Extinguish Gasoline Fire.

Experiments recently carried out by a British fire prevention committee show that the best way to extinguish a small gasoline fire is to spread over the burning liquid a mixture of ten pounds of bicarbonate of soda and twelve pounds of common sawdust. The sawdust need not be wet but must be free from chips and shavings. The theory is that the sawdust, by floating on the burning liquid, excludes the oxygen of the air, and the heat of the flame generates carbonic acid gas, which helps extinguish the fire. Sawdust alone gives satisfactory results, better than sand or similar materials.
