Trustee, 4 Faculty Honored At OCC

The Oakland Community College Faculty Assn. recently donated \$50 to its scholarship fund in honor of a board member and four faculty members, including two from Farmington Hills, who were active in contract negotiations.

In addition, the faculty group from the Orchard Ridge campus in Farmington Hills contributed \$50 to the fund in honor of Hugh Ritchie, associate professor of art, who designed a brochure on the campus' child play center.

The \$100 contribution was in honor of Gordon C. Henderson of Birmingham, chairman of the OCC Board of Trustees; Rodney Chase of Farmington Hills, chairman of the Orchard Ridge mathematics department; and Henry Gram of Farmington Hills, faculty negotiator and chairman of the Auburn Hills campus business department.

The contribution also honored John Homeister of Huntington Woods, business administration instructor at Orchard Ridge, and Allen J. Bogucki of Union Lake, faculty negotiator and chairman of the Highland Lakes business department.

Henderson and the faculty members were commended by Richard Smith, faculty president, for their efforts in negotiating a faculty contract and averting "operational and negotiations difficulties."

The scholarship fund was created this year, funded by a \$1 contribution per teacher per paycheck. The college has more than 300 instructors at its campuses at Orchard Ridge, Auburn Hills, Highland Lakes and southeast campus system in Oak Park and Royal Oak.

Details on the awards systems will be announced in the near future.

Ritchie designed and illustrated a brochure advertising the play center which drew special recognition from the Orchard Ridge faculty.

The play center handles children ages 2-6 between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. while their parents attend classes or study in the library.

Engineers List Oct. 11 Speaker

Stanford R. Ovshinsky, chairman of the board of Energy Conversion Devices, Inc., Troy, will discuss amorphous materials and the computer Oct. 11 at the Engineering Society of Detroit. The program, will begin at 7 p.m. at 100 Farnsworth, Detroit.

Ovshinsky has worked in the field of amorphous films since 1957. Together with his wife, Iris, he founded Energy Conversion Devices to continue research and development in amorphous materials for use in various phases of information storage and control combined with the concepts of energy conversion.

He has more than 40 U.S. patents and is the author of numerous scientific papers ranging from neuropsychology to amorphous semiconductors. His most recent developments have been in imaging. In 1968, he was the recipient of the Diesel gold medal for invention presented by the German Inventors Association.

Ovshinsky's discussion will include: amorphous materials utilized as switches, memory devices, optical storage and imaging media.
