The grants included \$24,000 from the U.S. Public Health Service for a study being conducted at the WSU School of Medicine by Assistant Prof. James A. Rillema, of 2801 Rambilla Road, South-field. He is studying how hor-mones affect the mammary glands during pregnancy and incitation.


