

OU Re-Elects Board Leaders

ROCHESTER The board of trustees of Oakland University has re-elected its chairman and vice chairman.

Otis M. Smith will serve a second year as board chairman and Arthur W. Saltzman as vice chairman. Both are among seven charter members of the eight-member board, having served since OU received autonomy from Michigan State University in 1970.

Smith is an assistant general counsel of General Motors Corp. He joined GM in 1967 after a career in Michigan government, including six years as a justice of the Michigan Supreme Court.

Saltzman is manager of personnel research and analysis dept. of Ford Motor Co. He has been with Ford since 1953. His wife is current president of the Birmingham Board of Education.

Nursing Degree Program Studied By Oakland U

ROCHESTER The director of the Providence Hospital School of Nursing in Southfield has accepted a special appointment to the faculty at Oakland University, Rochester.

Miss Agnes C. McMenemy of Farmington is helping plan a bachelor of science degree program in nursing at Oakland.

She will serve in a consulting role as adjunct associate professor of nursing and assistant to the provost for nursing while continuing as director at Providence.

The university, with the help of nursing educators at Providence along with others, is planning a four-year degree program. Providence and other hospitals will provide off-campus practicum

experience with OU offering the academic training.

Implementation is being sought for the fall of 1974, if approval is received from the State Board of Education.

Providence is phasing out its two-year, diploma granting nursing program and will graduate its last students in 1975, a year after Oakland hopes to admit its first students.

4 From Area Benefit From WSU Grants

Four Wayne State University faculty members from Southfield and Farmington had research grants and contracts approved at a recent meeting of the WSU Board of Governors.

The grants included \$24,000 from the U.S. Public Health Service for a study being conducted at the WSU School of Medicine by Assistant Prof. James A. Rullema, of 29661 Rambling Road, Southfield. He is studying how hormones affect the mammary glands during pregnancy and lactation.

A second study at the WSU School of Medicine, by Asst. Prof. Erwin Robin, of 18811 Hampshire, Lathrup Village, was funded by a \$9,000 grant from the Michigan Heart Association. Dr. Robin is studying the possible relationship between drug addiction and heart valve infection.

Two Farmington men associated with the College of Engineering were also awarded grants. Asst. Prof. Ronald R. Mourant, 28701 Aranel, will use \$47,000 provided by General Motors Corp. to study how drivers use and are affected by rear-view mirrors.

Asst. Dean H. Allen Knappenberger, of 29582 Foxgrove, will develop a course for command personnel at the Tank Automotive Command in Warren. The U.S. Army provided \$6,000 for the course in control systems, reliability engineering, and materials science.

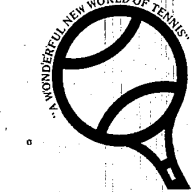
