FARMINGTON Farmington School District and teacher negotiators were meeting at the Michigan Employee Relations Commission offices in Detroit at 10 a.m. Wednesday.

"All I can say is they are

negotiating," said Supt. Mar-

tinus Van Ameyde.

A crowded school board

meeting Monday evening

heard few comments from

the school board on the first

teacher walkout in Farm-

ington's history.

Board President Mervyn

Ross accused the FEA of

"succumbing to Michigan

Education Assn. plans... as

evidenced by a strike vote

and action taken today."

Ross was referring to ear-

lier reports that the MEA

was encouraging districts to

strike this fall.

"It is unfortunate that the

FEA has deemed to take an

illegal strike," stated Ross.

"We believe it is illegal and

of no useful purpose. Stu-

dents and parents are caught

in the middle."

Ross concluded by voicing

support for the district's ne-

gotiators and by urging ne-

gotiations to continue.

Roger Allen, executive se-

cretary of the FEA, reacted

by warning against a "hard-

ened" position which would

cause "extreme delay" in

reaching a settlement.
