Now it seems to me that West might've done very well at this point to bid nothing but I admit that that's open to question. One really can't fault 2 H too much; North's leap to 4 D was inspired bidding; please notice that he did not cue bid hearts but was content to make the iump raise.

A lot of you may not like East's 4 H bid but I beg you to notice that that contract is on ice (after all, East hadn't




