LWV Will Host Latin Visitors

Eight women from Latin America will be guests of the Farmington - West Bloomfield League of Women Voters on Thursday, Oct. 18, as part of a study trip to this country.

The visitors are participating in a five-week multinational seminar titled "Coordination of Resources for Community Action."

The seminar is co-sponsored by the U.S. State Department and the overseas education fund of the League of Women Voters.

Included in the seminar, based in Washington, is two weeks of visits to American cities. Detroit was included on the itinerary because of the wide range of community

action programs instituted in the area during the past decade.

The Farmington - West Bloomfield league will entertain the Latin Americans and their interpreter at a luncheon Oct. 18 in the Orchard Lake home of Maryalice Casey, a member of the local league and president of the Michigan League of Women Voters.

Following the luncheon, LWV members will take the guests on a tour of Cranbrook Institute and then will put on a program in the Cranbrook auditorium highlighting programs leagues in Michigan have developed to solve problems in their communities.

Bridge Hand While They Last

The hallmark of the successful defender is the knowledge of when to hold off taking winners and when to race to cash them; sometimes the choice is a tossup but usually there's a clue. . . .

support for a vulnerable overcall, there's no point in fooling around. . . show the support immediately and let partner decide whether or not to go to bigger things.

Dummy played DJ and North won DA and was faced with an immediate choice. . . what to lead back. Remember please that this was duplicate bridge where overtricks are worth their weight in caviar. Now many of us might fiddle around trying to lead a trump or might hope to obtain a diamond ruff from South but North was the peerless pro, producer of Mission Impossible, Barry Crane.

He never even hesitated; he banded down HA, caught the H9 from South and continued with H10 to hold the contract to 10 tricks which little defensive move netted N-S 22-out of a possible 25 match points.

And how did he know to defend in that manner (I hear you wait)? Simplicity itself. . . initially, for South to have a singleton diamond was surely a possibility, but Crane figured that the ruff might wait; if South did not signal for a heart continuation, there was still time for the ruff try at trick 3; secondly, South figured to have one of the major kings since East had just overcalled instead of making some stronger bid; if it were the SK, it might or might not win a trick but if it were the HK, it had better be grabbed while the grabbin' was good for if it were EAST who had the stiff diamond, any other return would allow the uninterrupted running of four diamond tricks in dummy (after trump was yanked).

That's one of the reasons Crane has more master points than anyone else in history, folks. . . take a lesson from it!
