

# Hikers To Aid SC Loan Fund

The Schoolcraft College Collegiate Patriots Club has scheduled a hike-athon for Saturday, Oct. 27, to raise money for the student loan fund on campus.

The club welcomes walkers to join them on the approximately 10 miles along Edward Hines Parkway from Merriam Road to Northville. Marchers will leave in a group from Room B-170 of the Liberal Arts Building at 1 p.m.

Patriots' advisor Walter Lockhart said he is hoping for as many as 50 walkers. "We are also looking for backers who will sponsor walkers at so much per

mile," he added. "Any amount will be appreciated, from a flat rate donation of 10, 25 or 50 cents per mile."

Lockhart also said there will be need for extra drivers and a "volunteer squad" to give aid to any who falter along the way. "Philosophy instructors like myself shouldn't have any difficulty, but others might not quite be up to it," he said.

All proceeds will be earmarked for the non-interest loan fund Schoolcraft students borrow from. Persons on and off campus are welcome to participate in any way, and may contact Lockhart at the college.
