"FISH offers a program that can give real service, and helping requires not a great deal of time. But more people are needed."

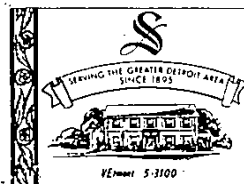
Benefit Card Party Is Set

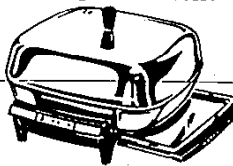
