#### **OU Enrolls** 900 More

Oakland University reports more than 9,500 students mare than 9,500 students have registered for classes this fall, a 17.5 per cent increase from a year ago. More than a quarter of the enrollment is at the graduate level.

"We have been convinced that Oakland will continue to grow despite the general recession in higher education," said OU President Donald D. O'Dowd in releasing the fall enrollment data. The graduate component of the university, launched in 1955, has been a steadily increasing percentage of the university enterprise. The 2,573 graduates registered this fall reflects a growth of 700 from last fall.

Four new masters programs - management, history, early childhood education, and guidance and counseling - were added to the graduate offerings this year.
