

# Missionary From Africa Slated

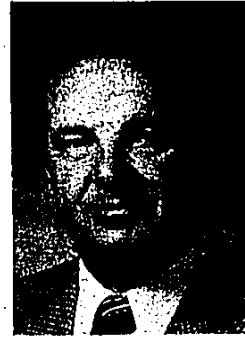
W. Baker, pastor of the Eleventh Street Church of God in Canton, Ohio.
