# Skating Has New Image

With today's emphasis on physical activities, many sports once low in popularity are enjoying a tremendous boom. Two are tennis and skiing.

Not all sports, however, have climbed the ranks so quickly, nor scored so highly with the general public. One such sport is roller skating.

Jack Hurley of Westland, president of the Michigan Roller Skating Union, feels this is due partly to a misconception on the part of the public.

"When most people hear of roller skating and competition, they think of the knock-down, drag-out roller derby. This just isn't true."

Hurley says roller skating is similar to ice skating. A competitive skater goes through figures, dance, freestyle, spins and jumps much the same as his ice counterpart.

Roller skating is divided into three classes: (1) artistic, (2) speed and (3) hockey.

The artistic class includes dances done to music, interpretive freestyle, jumps, spins and lifts.

Speed includes relay-type skating around a track, similar to speed skating on ice.

Hockey is also the same as on ice. This category, however, is just getting started in Michigan. According to Hurley, there is only one Michigan hockey team at present.

Hurley says the state association, which consists of 10 clubs and is affiliated with the U.S. Amateur Roller Skating Association, is in the process of training teams.

"We hope to have four hockey teams within the next two years. We plan to compete against other teams throughout the country."

At present, Hurley's club, which includes members from Livonia, Westland, Plymouth, Garden City, Farmington and Redford, is giving demonstrations for hospitals and convalescent homes. The club also participates in state and national club meets.

The club is a non-profit organization, and members aren't allowed to take money for any type of skating. Once a skater takes money, he's considered a professional, not an amateur. The only source of income for the club is ticket sales for competitive meets.

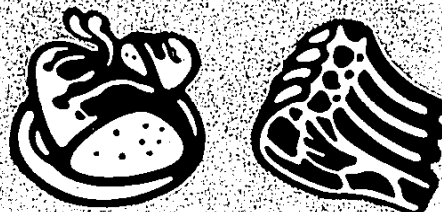
