OCC Sets Booth At Mall

Persons interested in attending the Orchard Ridge campus of Oakland Community College in Farmington Hills can get information on admission and registration from a booth in the Tel-Mall, Telegraph and 12 Mile in Southfield this week.

The booth will be manned from 11 a.m. until 8 p.m. through Friday. Free catalogs, career brochures and applications will be available.

A photo and slide presentation on the campus was prepared by John Yavrek, audio-visual technician, for the booth.

Citizens can fill out an application at the booth and get answers on transfer and career programs. They also can pick up information for mail-in registration.

"This is the first time we have offered mail registration to new applicants at the college," Dr. Donald Nichols, dean of students, said. "Special arrangements had to be made with our computer center for this service to new students."

The deadline for reserving winter classes by mail is Nov. 16. Students also can register during on-campus registration Jan. 2 to 11.

Airport Adds Shuttle Buses

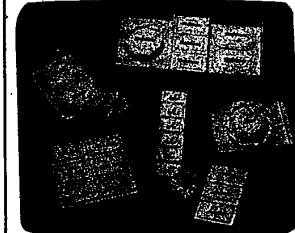
Michael Berry, chairman of the Board of Wayne County Road Commissioners, has announced a new service for patrons of Detroit Metropolitan Wayne County Airport.

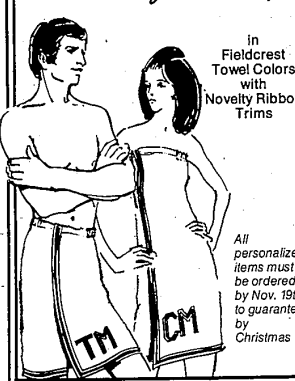


