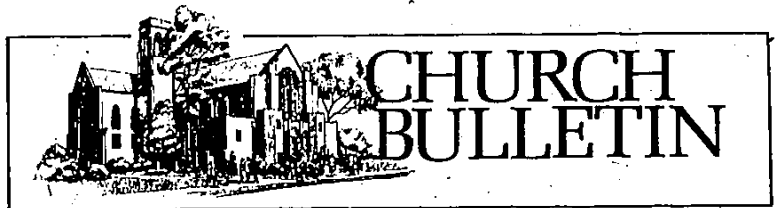

retirement home next to the
