

# Chamber Of Commerce Adds 72 To Membership

FARMINGTON The Farmington Chamber of Commerce has added 72 new members this year, bringing its total to 255. The record was credited

mainly to a recent membership drive conducted by the chamber, according to Ed Lane, executive secretary.

"When I started here just over a year ago, the membership was 100. We hope to hit 300 by the end of the year."

He estimated about 1,000 businesses in the Farmington area are potential chamber members.

The recent membership drive brought in 50 of the new members, and about half of the 50 are credited to the "team" headed by Chamber President William Flattery.

Other team members were Ray Campbell, Mary Anderson, Jim Sinner, Gerald Bremer, and Jim Berney.

The individual bringing in the most new members was Robert Smith, with 13 to his credit.

## Brooks Patterson Talks To Chamber

FARMINGTON L. Brooks Patterson, Oakland County prosecutor, will be the featured speaker at the Dec. 13 general membership breakfast, of the Farmington Chamber of Commerce at 8 a.m. in the Bedford Inn.

Patterson was elected prosecutor as a Republican last year, defeating his old boss, Democrat Thomas Plunkett.

He joined the county as assistant prosecutor and senior trial lawyer following graduation from University of Detroit Law School in 1968.

His election to the office followed his well-publicized work as lawyer for Irene McCabe's NAG anti-busing group.

As prosecutor, Patterson supervises a 41-man staff of assistant prosecutors, six investigators and other office departments.

Patterson, 34, lives in Troy. He is a 1961 graduate of the University of Detroit.

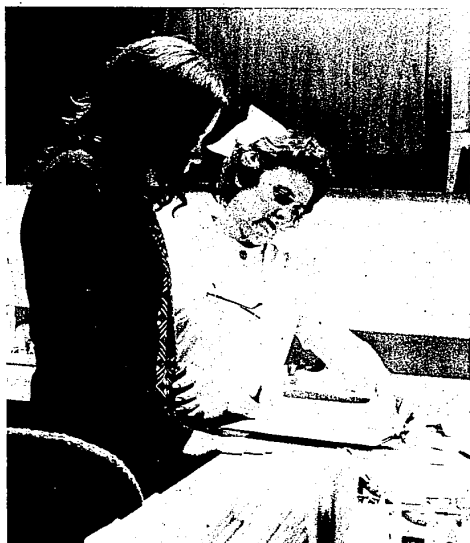
### Toys Banned
