**S'craft Expansion Rests With State**

A three-pronged expansion program is being planned at Schoolcraft College - provided the State Municipal Finance Commission grants permission to shift priorities listed in the 1968 bond issue.

If permission is granted, plans call for a new wing on the administration building, expansion of outdoor facilities in the athletic department and enlarged quarters for the culinary arts program in the Lois Waterman building.

The shifts in the 1968 priorities that would release the necessary funds for the expansion have been approved by the Board of Trustees and now await only the word from the Finance Commission.

The new wing on the administration building will fill a gap for office space that

has been brought about by the continuing growth.

Ground for the proposed outdoor playfields was obtained recently in a deal with the State Highway Department along the route of the new expressway.

This is a parcel of 22 acres that will be devoted to tennis courts (exact number not known) and two playfields for soccer and other outdoor sports.

Interest in these outdoor activities, especially soccer, has grown during the past year when the school's varsity team advanced to the semi-finals of the national tournament.

With this interest on the upgrade, the board, for the first time, is financing the program out of general funds and has set up a special traveling account for the teams and individuals competing in events removed from the campus.


Work on this extension will start as soon as approval is given by the Finance Commission and the project is to cost approximately \$440,000.

The administration building wing will cost approximately \$215,998, while \$116,150 is being budgeted for the tennis courts and playfields to be developed on the ground adjacent to the physical education building.




