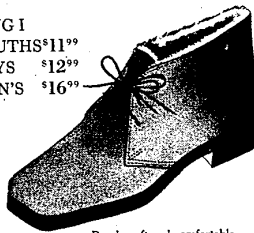


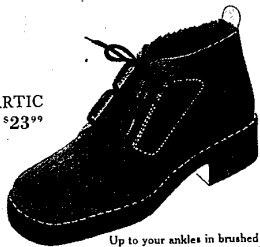

## 2 Vets Lead OCC Student Affairs

Two Farmington veterans have been elected to student government leadership positions on the Orchard Ridge campus of Oakland Community College in Farmington Hills.

Frank Montour was elected president of the 6,000 student campus and Guido Tenaglia was elected vice president. Both are graduates of Farmington High School and are sophomores at Orchard Ridge.

Both Montour and Tenaglia were active in the Academic Senate, a campus association of students, faculty and administrators. They spearheaded a movement which resulted in expansion of student health services on campus.

Montour and Tenaglia hold 4.0 (straight A) grade point averages at OCC.

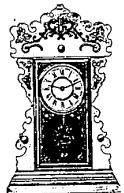
Montour is also active in the American Indian movement. Proud of his Mohawk heritage, he was instrumental in initiating an American Indian culture course in the anthropology department.

If requested, Consumers Power will arrange for installation of ceiling insulation in the customer's home. The cost of such installation can be paid for in monthly installments as part of your monthly gas bill. Details available at your nearest Consumers Power office.
