## Nursing Home Legislation Is The Topic

**FARMINGTON**  
A meeting to explain new and pending state legislation affecting nursing homes will be held at 7:30 p.m. Thursday, Dec. 13, in the Williamsburg Convalescent Center, 2107 Middle Belt, Farmington.  
The meeting is sponsored by Macomb, Oakland, St. Clair Diabetic Assn. (MOST), comprised of registered dietitians from the three-county area.  
Most of the members serve as consultants to small hospitals and nursing homes. Association president is Mrs. Elliot Burns, R.D., of Southfield.

Slate Rep. Joseph Forbes (D-Oak Park) whose 67th District includes Southfield and Lehigh Village, will speak on pending state legislation as it affects nursing home operators and patients.

In 1972, Forbes chaired a special House committee to study nursing homes in Michigan. His committee held four public hearings and is presently studying the possibility of introducing new bills.

Forbes, now in his second term in the House, served as Oak Park mayor for six years. He is presently chairman of the House Urban Affairs Committee, vice-chairman of the Elections Committee, and a member of the Consumers and Agriculture and Towns and Counties committees.
