Boar's Head New Tradition For St. Paul

"The Boar's Head Festival," a medieval interpretation of the Christmas story, will be presented in St. Paul Presbyterian Church, 27475 Five Mile, Livonia, on Saturday and Sunday, Dec. 15 and 16, at 5 p.m.

In a pageant the church hopes to make an annual Christmas tradition, St. Paul will combine the music of its 97-rank organ, 20-piece orchestra, and choirs with the drama of a costumed cast of 100.

An Old English Feast in the church social hall will follow the pageant. Strolling musicians will be on hand.

The Boar's head ceremony is probably the oldest continuing festival of the Christmas season. First presented in 1340 at Queen's College, Oxford, it was brought to America and used in colonial homes. The first public presentation was in Hoosick Falls, N.Y., in 1888.

In the St. Paul version, there will be a procession of the Beefeaters, traditional guardians of the king, the coming of the Yule Sprite and the presentation of the boar's head.

Since ancient times, the wild boar has been the symbol of evil, so the presentation of the boar's head represents the victory of the Christ Child over evil.

Also included will be bringing in the Yule log, which symbolizes the rekindling of love and promise for the year ahead.

There is no charge for the festival presentation. A free will offering will be taken.

The Old English Feast, featuring a menu of Cornish game hens stuffed with rice, and flaming plum pudding, will cost \$3 for adults and \$2 for children under 12. Tickets should be reserved at the church office.
