Bach for a Buck, still just \$1, will present repeat performances Friday and Saturday, Dec. 28 and 29, at 8:30 p.m. in the Italian Gothic chapel of Duns Scotus, Nine Mile and Evergreen, Southfield.

Detroit Symphony bassist Raymond Benner, artistic director and founder of Bach for a Buck, will preside over the week-long Bach workshop which culminates in the concert.

Benner will bring together the area's finest young artists home for the holidays from the various music schools and conservatories. Assisted by colleagues Shaul Ben-Meir and Hart Hollman, the Duns Scotus Chamber Players will join with the John

Doveras Singers for this third annual event. Soloists from among the young artists are violinists Sheila Fiekowsky and Kirk Toth and cellist Deborah Fayrolan.

Miss Fiekowsky, recently graduated from the Curtis Institute of Music and now attending Yale, will also serve as concertmistress. A native Detroit resident is studying now with Joseph Silverstein and played under Casals in his last years at Marlboro. Imogene Bird of the John Doveras Singers will be soprano soloist. Violist Hollman will join harpsichordist Muriel Kilby in Sonata No. 2 in A major on Friday night.
