The Michigan Department of Natural Resources reminds spear and bow and arrow lishermen that they again may take yellow perch from Lake St. Clair in January and Pebruary.
The DNR Fisheries Division recommended this summer that Lake ISt. Clair be reopened to perch spearing, which it termed a "traditional sport" as practiced primarily in the Anchor Bay area north of Mount Clemens. The recommendation was approved by the Natural Resources Commission in August.
