While keeping them in their natural state, Pursell said that the lakes will be useful for recreational purposes when the cleaning project is completed.

Snell, whose firm has done similar studies both in and out of Michigan, said "dredging is probably a very practical approach" to improving the lakes because deepening them would inhibit the growth of weeds and algae. "I'm convinced that there are many things that can be done just from my brief view of the lakes this morning."

Disposing of the sediment dredged from the lakes is the prime problems since there aren't marsh areas nearby to dump the sediment, he said.

"This is a real challenge," he said adding that it's not practical to truck it away and that they want to dump it somewhere where it can do some good.


