Reserves name Farmington man head

A Farmington man has been named commanding general of the 70th division (training) U.S. Army Reserves, headquartered at 34451 Schoolcraft Rd., Livonia.
Brig. General Naiff H. Kelel, 31560 Rocky Crest Dr., Farmington, joined the Army Air Corps as an enlisted man in 1943. He transferred to the infantry in 1944 and was commissioned in 1945. Kelel served in the Pacific as a platoon leader and was company commander during the occupation of Japan.
In the reserve, he served with 398th Military Police Battalion. His positions include logistics officer, chief of staff, deputy commander and commander.

He was promoted to brigadier general in 1970.
Kelel is owner of Greenfield American Inc., in Detroit. He is a member of the Greater Detroit Chamber of Commerce, vice president of the Staman Acres Civic Assn., president of the American Motors Detroit Dealers Assn. and on many committees of the Army Reserve.
His appointment took effect Jan. 13.
