Weekend College, an innovative adult education program, will be offered in the Farmington area beginning Feb. 9.

Sponsored through the adult degree program of John Wesley College in Owosso, its local program will be held in the University Hills-Christian Center, 27000 Farmington Road.

Offered here will be "Methods and techniques of adult learning," to be taught by Ed Bunnell, provost of continuing education at John

Wesley; "Great religions of the world," with Dr. Harold Ellens, minister of University Hills Church, and "Contemporary man's search for meaning," to be taught by the Rev. Elvin Clark.

The adult degree program (ADP) is structured for adults who are unable to participate in standard academic programs.

periences to meet their individual needs.

Work may be taken to earn undergraduate degree credit or to broaden perspectives.

As the program works, ADP students work closely with a faculty advisor and also engage in independent study.
