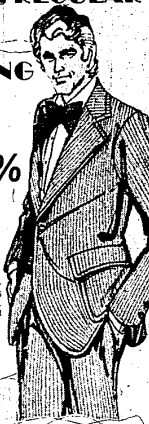

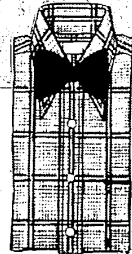

Several of his students, reports Oakland Community College associate professor Larry O'Keefe of Plymouth, really have their subject matter down cold. They'd better. They're studying ice sculpture in the hospitality industry program O'Keefe teaches on the Orchard Ridge OCC campus, 2765 Orchard Lake Road, Farmington. The class members' creations, including a seal, a Grecian urn, a swan and a basket of flowers, currently are in cold storage in the walk-in freezer that is part of the equipment used by students in the program. They will be brought out for the international dinner planned on the campus in March and for the food service awards banquet later in the spring. The chilly artistic participants include Bill Roysse of Pontiac, Peg Barber of Pontiac, John Hanson of Detroit and Mike Forbes of Detroit. Paul Friewald, who formerly taught ice carving at Orchard Ridge, also helped create the masterpieces currently on ice. The Orchard Ridge program includes courses of either one or two years of study. Ice-carving is one small facet of the course, which includes study and practical

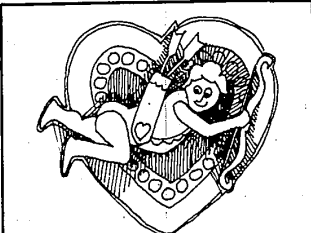
