A drawing will follow the demonstration to see who

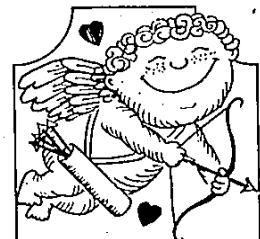
