Civitan to honor Rev. McDonald

The Rev. B. Edwin McDonald, pastor of the Plymouth Church of the Nazarene, will be honored by the Plymouth Community Civitan Club when it holds a Feb. 14 dinner as part of Plymouth community clergy-men week.

Mike Caffery, chairman of the program, said all clergymen in the Plymouth area are invited to the dinner with Civitan members, scheduled at 7 p.m. in the Miles Standish room of the Mayflower Hotel.

Pastor McDonald is being singled out for special honors, he added, because of several community service projects in which his congregation has been engaged.

These include sending Sunday services into the West Trail Nursing Home by direct telephone line so that patients there can "attend" church and sending buses to the Camelot Nursing Home to take some of its residents to church.

The honoring of the clergy, a tradition at this time of year for Civitan clubs all over the country, com-

memorates the sacrifice of four chaplains who on Feb. 3, 1943, went down with the troop transport Dorchester in the north Atlantic because they had given their life jackets to soldiers who lost theirs.

"Civitan is interested in citizenship," Caffery said, "and that is why we are particularly interested in Rev. McDonald's community service as we honor the ministers and priests of this area during International Clergy Week."
