Topic of his 8 p.m. lecture will be "A Perspective on Contemporary Craftsman."

Glick, who has earned degrees from Wayne State University and Cranbrook, operates a family enterprise, Plumtree Pottery, in a century old farmhouse on 10 Mile Rd.

He produces his ceramic pieces from mixing the clay to firing it in self made kilns.

Glick observed the family potteries in operation in Germany while he was in military service there.
