

# Planting of area waters relieve angler's boredom

were stocked in 1973. Got your map and a pencil? Let's check:

## OAKLAND COUNTY

Huron River in the Proud Lake State Recreation Area: 2,000 brown trout yearlings.  
Proud Lake: 5,000 yearling rainbows in the lower lake, 5,000 more in the upper lake. These lakes and the planned stretch of the Huron River are in Commerce Township, north of Wixom.

Kearley Creek, Groveland and Brandon Townships near Ortonville: 1,000 brown trout yearlings.

Pink Creek in Avon and Oakland Townships: 1,000 yearling brownies.

Loon Lake, next to Dixie Highway in Waterford Township: 8,000 yearling brownies, 16,000 yearling rainbows.

Union Lake, in West Bloomfield and Commerce Townships: 18,000 yearling rainbows, 7,000 yearling splake (hybrid brook-lake trout).

Cass Lake, West Bloomfield: 15,000 lake trout in a range of sizes.

In passing this list onto you, I'm not saying the fish will be there when you angle for 'em or that they'll even survive. It's just a report on where they

angling northern pike, 800 walleye fingerlings, 5,000 perch fingerlings. (Years ago, Kent used to be a hot spot for the sporty northern pike, but hardly anyone had got one there in recent times. Here's hoping the toothy junkies make a comeback.)

Clinton River, Waterford (Sec. 28): 50,000 yearling steelheads.

Deer Lake, Clarkston: 10,000 yearling splake.

Crooked Lake, Independence Township: 500 northern pike yearlings.  
Hubbel Pond, Milford Township: 113,000 walleye fingerlings.

## WAYNE COUNTY

Belleville Lake, in Van Buren Township southwest of these parts, got most of the plantings after its native population, mostly carp and other rough fish, was killed off last year. Here is the new population:

Rainbow trout: 108,000 yearlings, more than 700 adults.

Largemouth black bass: More than 78,000 fingerlings.

Tiger muskies: 24 adults.

Walleyes: nearly 2,900 fingerlings.

Bluegills: 78,000 fingerlings, 31 adults. (Hmmm, wonder how that odd adult will mate.)

Green sunfish: 1,750 fingerlings.

Fathead minnows: 52,900 yearlings.

Around Belle Isle, the Detroit River got 20,000 rainbow trout yearlings, 60,000 steelhead yearlings and 301,500 chinook salmon fingerlings.

## LIVINGSTON COUNTY

Appleton Lake, 5,600 rainbow yearlings; Lime Lake, 3,000 rainbow yearlings; Murray Lake, 2,400 rainbow yearlings. All three lakes are in the northern part of Hamburg Township in the Brighton State Recreation Area.

Silver Lake, Green Oak Township:

300 northern pike fingerlings.  
Woodland Lake, Brighton Township: 1,200 tiger muskies/fingerlings.

Strawberry and Whitewood Lakes, on the Huron River chain in Hamburg Township: 1,000,000 walleye fry, between them.

## MACOMB COUNTY

East Pond Creek, in Bruce Township in the northwestern part of the county: 500 yearling brown trout.

Clinton River's North Branch, Macomb Township: 32,000 yearling steelhead.

## Seaholm romps in swim meet

Barracuda - quick, Birmingham Seaholm's varsity swimmers splashed past Coach Bob Harding's Southfield Blue Jays 115-54 in a one-sided dual meet finale last week.

Coach Mike Heick's visiting Maples headed eight individual events plus both team relays during the South-eastern Michigan Association (SMA) collision.

Anchoring Seaholm's shiny showing were senior Tom Hewitt and junior Steve Kratt, each of whom emerged as a double winner.

KRATT DELIVERED a particularly notable performance in the 200-yard individual medley, posting a new pool/target of 2:04.

## 16 matmen get places

Bloomfield Hills' on-the-move Olympic Wrestling Club (OWC) delivered one of the shinier team showings during the Hazel Park Edison Wrestling Invitational last week.

OWC placed 16 of the 24 boys it entered in the invitational, which attracted more than 230 of Michigan's top junior grapplers.

Pacing OWC were Duck Hastings and Duke Wilson, both of whom chalked up firsts enroute to staying undefeated.

HASTINGS, a 72-pounder, now is 14-0, with 12 wins by pin. Wilson, a 58-pounder, now is 15-0.

Although only 10 years old, Hastings will compete in the 11-12 age bracket for the remainder of the season to experience tougher competition.

Taking OWC's other firsts were Andy Boddy and John Segula. Boddy, a 60-pounder, now is 13-1, with three firsts and 10 pins to his credit.

SEGULA, A 78-pounder, registered his second first of the season on the strength of two come-from-behind pins.

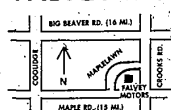
