

NOTICE TO CUT WEEDS
CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS
OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN

It shall be the duty of all owners of any subdivided land in any subdivisions located within the boundaries of the City of Farmington Hills to destroy any noxious weeds growing on said property before they reach a seed bearing stage so as to prevent them from becoming a detriment to public health. Any weeds not cut by July 15, 1974, will be cut by the City and the owner of the property charged with the cost of the same. The City of Farmington Hills hereby declares that many noxious weeds are under provisions of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 19596, which makes it unlawful for any owner to grow or maintain noxious weeds on his property. In addition any owner who shall refuse to destroy such noxious weeds as provided for in this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$100.

Noxious weeds are those described in Section 2 of Act 359 of the Public Acts of 1941, as amended, and all other weeds, wild grasses and plants, the uncontrolled growth of which is a public nuisance.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a special election will be held in Farmington Public School District, County of Oakland, and State of Michigan, on Tuesday, the 2nd day of April, 1976, for the purpose of submitting the following proposition:

In order to renew the five mill operating tax increase with exp. 12/31/73, such the limitation of the total amount of general and valuable tangible property which may be imposed for all purposes in any one year on real and tangible personal property in Farmington Public Schools District, Oakland County, Michigan, be increased as provided in Section 6, Article 13, of the Constitution of Michigan, for a period of ten years from 1974 to 1983, both inclusive, by five (5) mills on each dollar (\$0.05 per \$1.00) of assessed valuation of property as finally equalized, for the purpose of defraying a part of the operation expense of the school district?
