Michigan State University horticul-urists and turfgrass specialists rec-mmend this April guide for home-wners and gardeners:

**Don't start your spring vegetable garden too soon. Let the soil dry out before working it. The soil is ready when a bail of it will crumble in your than the soil is ready to be worked, fertilize it with a complete fertilize.

Slart your transfer.

*Start your tomato plants indoors about six weeks before you plan to transplant there mostly start radishes, leaf and head lettuce, onion sels, peas, greens, broccoli and cabbage.

*Late in the month, plant table beets, carrots, spinach, parsnips, rabberries, strawberries, grapes, rhubarb, asparagus roots and fruit trees.

**Thanke of any special services and fruit test.

**Harden your indoor plants before transplanting them outdoors. To do this, withhold water and lower temperatures. Place them outdoors in a protected area during the day and bring them indoors at night.

**Get ready for spring flowering beds. Remove half the winter mulch from your flower beds now and the remaining a week or two later. Clean up clumps of dead iris leaves and roten thizomes.

**Fast growing annuals may best growing annuals may be started indoors this month. These include: marigolds, calendula, cosmos, scabiosa and gaillardia.

•Fertilize your shade and flowering

*Fertilize your shade and flowering trees.
 *If you are planning to add some trees and shrubs to your landscape, now is the time to do it.
 *Leave the feliage on Easter, Ililes until they turn brown. Then remove the bulb and root mass and plant them outdoors. Littles will bloom in succeeding years in June or July.
 *Control spider mittes, spruce gail aphids and scale insects by applying dormant sprays before buds upon and shoot growth starts.
 *Spray Irid. Less as soon as *Spray Irid. continue at 7 to 10 day intervals. Do not spray them when they are in full bloom. An all-purpose fruit spray is the easiest to use.
 *Rake out any spots of snowmold as soon as you spot them.
 *Reseed any bare spots in your leavn if the soils in olonger muddy.


