"They (DePorres) have won our meet for three years in a row. They have a good bunch of kids," said George Browne, Country Day track coach and meet director.

COUNTRY DAY, one of the few teams with a chance to end DePorres' string, got a strong performance from junior David Merritt, who shattered the meet long jump record with a 22°3½" leap. Merritt also took second in the high jump at 6°2".

Another Yellow Jacket, Harry Davis, finished first in the 180-yard low hurdles in :19.8. He added a second place in the 120-yard high hurdles in :15.0.
