# Cranbrook third in Foley Relays

Beginning to prosper after a sluggish start, Bloomfield Hills Cranbrook's varsity tracksters ranked third during the premiere Madison Heights Bishop Foley Relays Saturday.

Coach Ben Snyder's Cranes posted one first, two seconds, one third and three fifths enroute to totaling 38 points, 46 less than pacesetter Flint Powers Catholic.

"I felt we performed quite respectable," Snyder said.

Runner-up honors went to South Lyon with 46 points. Auburn Heights Avondale finished fourth, registering 32 points.

THE SHINIEST showing for Cranbrook was its shot-put relay, which won with a combined heave of 136-5/8.

Relay members were senior Kevin Merigian plus sophomores Clark Shuler and Mark Smith.

Taking seconds for the Cranes were its 440 shot-putters' relay and high jump relay.

Shot-putters' relay members were freshman Dave House, along with Merigian, Shuler and Smith. High jump relay members were

senior Mike Manhart, juniors Craig Dolby and Cam Smart.

- Sprint medley (senior Nate Wimberly, junior Greg Mast, Guinn and Nederlander), fifth.

- 880 (junior Francisco DeJesus, Mast and Nederlander), fifth.

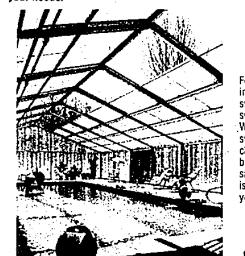
