A WOMAN hostage taken by the pair Saturday was killed Sunday as she tried to escape in Wisconsin. Later Sunday, a Milwahkee gas station attendant was shot and killed.

Warrants have been issued for Molinare and Stockenauer in the death of the hostage, Charlene Beaudin, a Marquette waitress.

Police are investigating the pair's possible involvement in the Milwaukee shooting.

Molinare and Stockenauer stood mute at their arraignment. Pleas of innocent were entered for both by Troy Municipal Judge Wilbur Bollinger.

Molinare and Stockenauer declined to enter pleas until they could confer with court-appointed attorneys.

TROY POLICE CPL. Thomas Morris told Bollinger both men confessed to their parts in the Troy slaying. Molinare fired the two ri-fle shots that killed Chivas, Morris

fle shots that killed Chivas, Morris said.

Judge Bollinger ordered both men held without bond in the Oakland County Jail. A pre-trial examination will be held at 9 a.m. Monday before Judge Bollinger.

At the arraignment, Morris chronieled how Molinare and Stockenauer left a trail of terror from Marquette through Oskosh and Milwaukee, Wisconsin, Troy, Madison Heights, Warren, Southfield, and finally, Fiint.

The pair escaped late Friday from the Marquette state prison. Both were serving sentences for following saskil. Molinare had been sentenced to one-ot-three years.

Molinare and Stockenauer waited overnight in a wooded area, Morris said, then stole rifles and went to a restaurant where they abducted Mrs. Beaudin and stole

When that vehicle broke down near Carney, 80 miles south of Marquette, the pair are reported to have captured William Klingenmaier, the escapees thought they would find a plant

was pronounced dead at 3:40 a.m. MEANWHILE, MORRIS said, Molinare and Stockenauer went to Denny's Restaurant at Tweive Mile and Stephenson, where they attempted to take another hostage and steal a car. Their intended victim screamed, and a patron came to her rescue." Some shooting broke out, Morris said.

The escapese fied to Warren. At about 5 a.m., they convinced Rich Inatome, 20, to let them into his family's home. Inatome said thought friends were knocking at the door.

In Southfield, at Twelve Mile and Telegraph, Molinare and Stockenauer left Inatome, who went to Southfield police.

Flint police were alerted because authorities expected Molinare might try to return to the city he lived in before his conviction.

The Gremlin was spotted at about 7:30 a.m. and surrounded. Molinare and Stockenauer fled the car and were captured nearby.
