Turkey Shoot to gun down cancer

An all-day Turkey Shoot will be sponsored by the Oakland County Sportsman Club to benefit the American Cancer Society.

The event will be held Saturday beginning at 7:30 a.m. with registration for the shooters and a pancake breakfast on the club grounds, one-quarter mile east of U.S. 10 on

Waterford Road. American Cancer Society flags will mark all roads leading to the club entrance.

Co-chairmen of the affair are Carmen and Leo Tillard from Troy, who are working with Jerry Chiapetta of West Bloomfield, host of "Michigan Outdoors TV

show, acting as honorary chairman.

Entrance to the grounds and parking is free. Guests may use the outdoor fireplaces for lunch or purchase snacks from the American Cancer Society committee.

Shooters' entry fee is \$5 for trap and shoot matches. Guests may bring their own guns; some will be provided.

Bingo games will run continuously through the day in the club house, manned by members of the American Cancer Society committee.

A special guest for the day will be R. C. (Red) Hill, one of the top 10 skeet shooters in the world, along with a host of celebrities who will vie in matches and challenges.

Adventists aid schools

Education ranks high in priorities for Seventh-day Adventist church giving. Nine school projects are slated to benefit from the Troy Adventists' Missions Extension Fund this year.

The schools are located from Jamaica to New Guinea and range from a new little grade school in Cayo, South Haiti, to a library building for the Phoenix Adventist College in Mauritius, in the Indian Ocean area, and a residence for student nurses at Andrews Memorial Hospital in Kingston, Jamaica.

An exception to the educational list of mission projects is the inauguration of two new medical launches on the Amazon River in Brazil. The church operates more than a dozen such launches in its outreach to the isolated villages of the vast Amazon hinterlands.

Even the launch work is tied in closely with the educational work, for at regular launch stops the mission usually establishes a clinic and eventually the people request a school. Then the problem becomes one of personnel to adequately staff the schools, according to Shirley Dudney, Adventist Sabbath School superintendent.

Currently the denomination operates more than 4,500 schools and colleges through nearly 200 countries of the world. To maintain this and other aspects of the church's broad mission program, members give heavily.

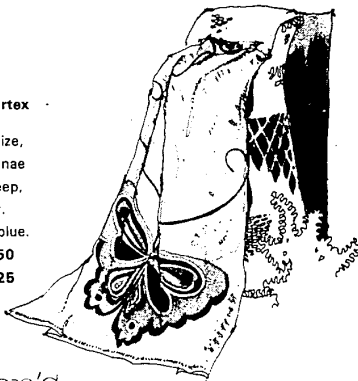

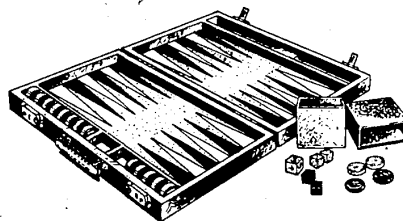

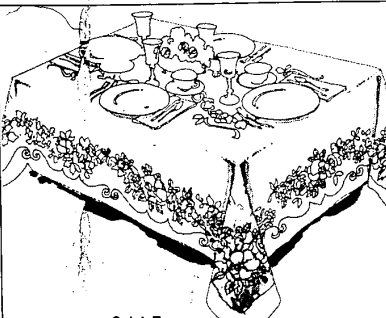
