Perfect small area

As you begin to gain momentum preparing your garden for your 1974 pleasure remember hopping from area to area in total frustration with the job at hand will get you nowhere.

As you organize the annual show in your garden remember that a grouping of vivid colors can make the visitor hold his breathe as they take in the splendor.

Therefore be daring.

Plant annuals in masses and not in strings. Play with color. Study a Mexican scene in a picture to know what I mean. Red, pink, and a certain intensity of purple are good.

All hues of yellow, orange massed together are good examples. 1974 is not a monochromatic age.

If you wish to have a good performance with your plants shipped to you, soak roots of trees and shrubs for 24 hours in water containing a weak fertilizer and one of the hormone-vitamin B-1 starters. If you have a grouping of trees

and the weekly cutting of grass is an extra chore, join together the trees into one bed. The total pattern could be kidney shaped.

Now fill the pattern with a good ground cover. Chances-are if the area is very shady pachysandra will be the answer. Incorporate a grouping of boulders in the composition or a birdbath.

How many have tried sweet woodruff, an herb, for a ground cover in deep shade? It will have star shaped leaves and a delightful white flower. Go out of your way to give this idea a try.
