

The neighbors are talking about the pleasure of starting a garden and those who work in offices are already bragging about their plans to battle the cost of food inflation.

A vegetable garden must have a sunny location. Sometimes the shadow of a building or tree will give a shady location although the site may be on the east or west.

When children are involved it is important that they have a "say" in the shape of the garden and at least a section they can call their own to maintain.

It is important that the effort be successful. Careful reading of seed packages is essential and if plants are purchased they should be in prime condition.

Do a little verbal bragging about the children's participation. Visitors to the child's garden may help assure more interest in its appear-

A border of low-growing marigolds around the compact home vegetable garden will inhibit uninvited insects. This is a wonderful opportunity to expand the usual to-the-table vegetable selection.

Have you ever eaten kohlrabi right from the garden when the edible bulb on the stem is young. "Try it, you will like it".

Swiss chard is another good vegetable to introduce as the tops can be greens while the stalks can be eaten as asparague.

If you have once eaten fresh peas from the garden your food taste will be on a new plateau.

It is up to the leader in the family garden program to keep the project a pleasure for all participants, not as a chore but an opportunity to be active member of family togetherness.
