Conference gathers top area leaders

A rare gathering of community leaders will gather Tuesday, May 7, from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Orchard Ridge campus of OCC.

The community involvement conference is sponsored by the Farmington Community Arts Council, and is funded through a special grant from the Michigan Council for the Arts.

"The purpose of this conference is to familiarize members active in community groups with the numerous facets of community life," said Mrs. Marlowe Belanger, chairman of the event.

There will be 12 workshops offered in three sessions, including structure and leadership, publicity, finances, youth, senior citizens, environment, government, record keeping, and schools.

IN ADDITION, participants will have the opportunity to meet and interrelate with many key business leaders, government officials, church and school leaders.

The breakfast begins at 8:30 a.m., with Mrs. William Milliken keynoting the conference at 9 a.m.

Workshops begin at 10 a.m. and continue until 1 p.m., for a break for lunch. They continue at 2:15 p.m. and wrap up at 3:45 p.m.

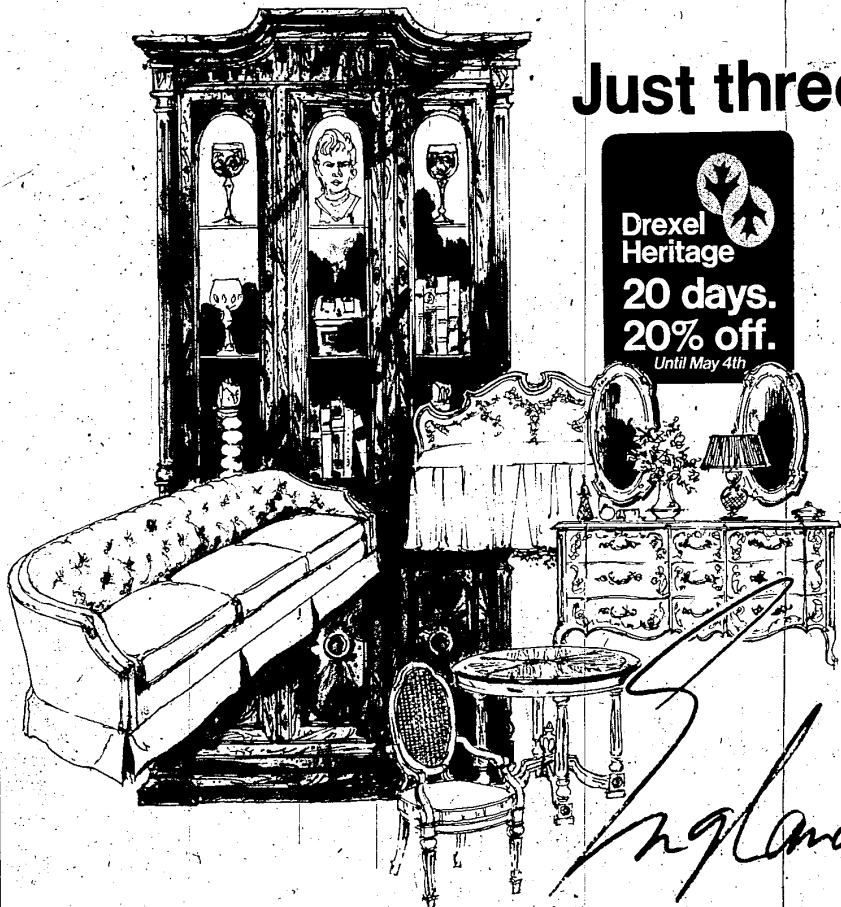
