Spring planting good for trees

Experimenting . . . I hung the moon on various Branches of the pine. Although trees may be planted at almost any time of year, many homeowners prefer to wait until spring when they can combine tree-planting with other outdoor projects.

There are several advantages to spring planting. First, rainfall, greatly contributing to root growth, is more abundant in spring than in fall. Also, in the more notherly regions, where soil freezes early and deep, spring planting is perhaps the safest.
