BAHIA (Floribunda). This All-America winner is alive with constant color. Add to the vivid pinkish-orange blooms a pleasing-spicy fragrance and a handsome coat of dark green foliage.

BON BON (Floribunda). Colorful, free blooming and densely covered with thick clusters of delightful pink and white bicolor blooms.

PERFUME DELIGHT (Hybrid Tea). The delightful brilliant pink blossom radiates a rich, spicy fragrance from long classic bud to beautiful 4½-5"

RED MASTERPIECE '(Hybrid Tea). Everything a classic red rose should be – and then some: from the exquisite dark red oval pointed buds that open to rich red flowers, to the vigorous attrac-

ACHILLEA (YARROW), 'Coronation Gold'. The bright golden yellow flower heads can be dried for lasting floral ar-

rangements.
ARUNDO DONAX, Resembles bamboo. The tall, arching grey green leaves create a good background for other plants.

ASTILBE, White, Pink or Red feathery, plumed plants which grow well in shady

DAYLILIES, Healthy, hardy, carefree plants in a wide range of colors from yellow to purple.

DELPHINIUM, Pacific Hybrid, Tow-ering spikes on 5 to 6 foot plants. Blooms in June and July.

ECHINOPS (GLOBE THISTLE) Handsome, round blue flower heads are fine for cutting. Can be dried.

FERN, Pteris Naclulosa, Ostrich feather fronds grow in shade or sun.

FUNKIA, Ideal plant for shade, with handsome green and white or solid green leaves and white or blue flowers. Several varieties offered.

LUPINE, Russell Hybrids, Tall, graceful flower spikes are made up of pea-shaped flowers in pink and blue shades.

LYTHRUM, 'Mordens Pink', Everblooming tall pink spikes. Effective in front of Delphinium.

PHLOX, Tall growing with brightly colored flower clusters in July and August. Many colors.

RUDBECKIA, Large, everblooming purple daisy.

EUONYMUS, ALATUS (BURNING BUSH), Entire plant turns brilliant red in

FORSYTHIA, 'Beatrice Farrand', Its large, golden yellow blossoms are the harbingers of spring.

HYDRANGEA, A. G., 'Hills of Snow', Large, round white flowers in June and July,

LILAC, Old fashioned purple favorite, with delightful fragrance. Blooms in

POTENTILLA, 'Coronation Triumph'.

A delightful small shrub, whose bright yellow flowers pravide cheerful color all summer long.

PRIVET, Golden Vicary, Golden yellow leaves provide colorful accent in the

SPIREA, DAPHNE, Rose-red flower clusters adorn this low growing shrub during August and September.

WEIGELA, 'Eva Rathke', An abundance of red trumpet blooms in July,

WINTERBERRY, Also called Michigan Holly. This tall glossy leaved shrub has an abundance of bright red berries which remain over winter.
