



Kenbrook school spirit sets pace for unique band unit

Sunday was a gay one at the Kenbrook School.
They had the annual school picnic and the annual marching band parade.
This year it was a parade of more than 60 children as the band stepped forward led by baton twirlers and accompanied by drums.
Kenbrook is a school with a lot of spirit. Adding to it is band teacher Stanley Wineberg who

conceived the delightful idea of an elementary school marching band.
KENBROOK HAS the only elementary school marching band in Oakland County.
"They march twice each year," explained Wineberg.
The first march is at this picnic and we don't prepare for it. It's all the kids in the band.
"But between now and Decoration day, they'll practice like crazy and be a real marching band in that parade."

Why a marching band for sixth graders?
"They'll be moving into junior high and it gives them a little experience for the marching band there. But even more, it gives them something to look forward to as they're learning during the school year."
"Marching in the city's parade is really a grand place to show off what they've learned."
A strong PTA at the Kenbrook school, led this year by President William Grayius is the sponsor of the annual picnic and carnival.
"We sell pizza and hot dogs, pop and popcorn, there's a midway in the gym with a cakewalk, games and a movie," said Grayius.
"There's a bike parade and then the marching band, with the police cars leading the way through the

subdivision with all their lights flashing.
"That's at 11:30. From 12:30 to 4 p.m. we have the picnic and carnival. We even had a moon walk this year."
The carnival netted \$2,170 this year which will leave about \$800-\$900 for special PTA projects. It's about the same amount as we made last year," Grayius said.
