

Lathrup scores 1 point

WL Western tops girls' meet

Southfield-Lathrup scored one point and tied with Royal Oak Kimball for 13th place in the All-Oakland County girls' track and field championships last Tuesday at West Bloomfield High.

Walled Lake Western compiled 95½ points to finish first. Ferndale finished second with 57 points, and Bloomfield Hills Lahser took third with 33.

Lathrup's Sally Boos finished sixth in the mile run in 6:09.3 to gain Lathrup's lone point.

Other good times for Lathrup: Gina Kunkel 1:55.8 in the 400-yard dash; Carol Cruickshank (2:43.4 in the 800-yard run) and Robin Larson (2:46.2 in the 880).

"These were excellent times for

them, like eight or nine seconds better than they've ever run."

Southfield High's girls' team failed to score, but coach Shari Gordon said she was pleased with her team's efforts.

"I was pleased because our girls ran against stiff competition, and they beat their own times, their own records," she said.

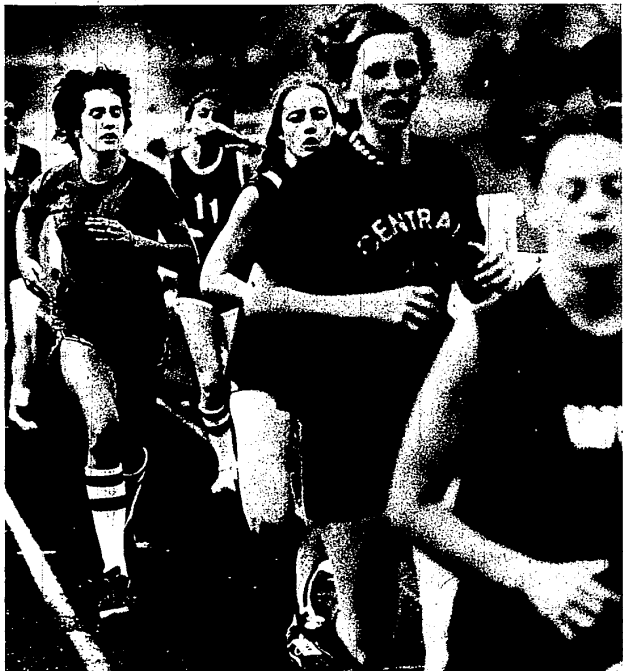

Churchill thinclads win

Harrison last in Western 6 track meet

Fred Price's Churchill cindermen made it a clean sweep in the Western Six.

After going 5-0 in dual competition,

the Chargers who won top honors in the 18 school Observer Relays, piled up a massive 94 points in the league meet to capture their third consecutive crown.

That makes it three out of four as Churchill placed second behind Waterford Mott in the first year.

Northville ran a distant second with 48 points, followed by Mott and Walled

Lake Western with 40 each. Plymouth Canton had 11 and Farmington Harrison with seven.

The field events saw Churchill rack up the points with two firsts, four seconds, two thirds and one fifth.

Overall Churchill took eight firsts with Bob Mendez a triple individual winner. Mendez won the low hurdles in :20.3; the high hurdles in :14.9; and the 220 yard dash in :22.9.

Other league champions for Churchill were Ken Voling in the high jump at 5 feet 3; Powers in the pole vault at 12 feet 4 and Wright in the two mile in 10:03.3.

The Chargers' also won the mile relay in 3:31.3. Results:

North Farmington tops Lathrup girls

North Farmington took firsts in eight of the 11 events and defeated Southfield - Lathrup, 58-33, last Thursday in a nonleague girls' track meet.

Lathrup's 880-yard relay team of Nancy Chirite, Amy Owen, Lisa Akerman and Gina Kunkel won in 2:12.0. The Chargers' 440-yard relay (Chirite, Owen, Shelia O'Donnell, and Val Rodriguez) finished first in :59.1. Lathrup's only other winner was Gina Kunkel, who topped the 440-yard dash in 1:10.7.

North Farmington had a triple winner in Julie Koteki. She won the 100-yard dash (:13.0), the 220-yard dash (:30.8) and the long jump (15-7½).

"It was real windy and they (North Farmington) had a cinder track. Our girls have never run on one," said Lathrup coach Mike Murphy. The loss ended Lathrup's season at 2-3 in dual meets.

"I think we improved all the way around," Murphy said. "People cut times remarkably. I have only one senior on the team now, so I'm really looking forward to next year."
