

## Boat launching facilities are open

Boat launching facilities of the Huron-Clinton Metropolitan Authority Metroparks are now open at Metropolitan Beach near Mt. Clemens, Stony Creek Metropark near Utica and Kensington Metropark near Milford.

**METROPOLITAN BEACH**, a 550-acre site near Mt. Clemens, has launching ramps that accommodate up to eight boats simultaneously located along the Black Creek which provide access to Lake St. Clair.

Adequate parking for boat trailers and cars is provided at the ramp or the 6,000-car parking lot. Due to the extremely high water along the Black Creek and Lake St. Clair, park officials caution boaters that the "No Wake" ordinance will be strictly enforced.

This year Metropark boat stickers are required for launching, with an annual permit costing \$5 or a daily permit costing \$1, which is in addition to the Metropark vehicle entry permit costing \$5 annual or \$1 daily.

At Metropolitan Beach, these charges are in effect from now through Sunday, Sept. 29, 1974 (charges vary at other Metropark launching sites since installation of toll booths is now in progress).

The ramps are open 6 a.m. to dusk, while the park is open daily 8 a.m. to dusk.

**STONY CREEK**, a 4,000-acre site north of Utica, has ramps that permit up to 10 launches and parking spaces for up to 150 cars and trailers located at the south end of Stony Creek Lake in the park.

There is a 10 mile-per-hour speed limit on the lake and no water skiing is permitted. The building at the launch site has restrooms, lounge area, vending machines for food service and a snack bar on week-ends. Fish that inhabit Stony Creek Lake include panfish, pike and bass.

Boaters are required to have a water craft launch permit which registers the boat with Stony Creek Metropark and explains boating regulations (which also may be used at Kensington Metropark).

## How to travel inexpensively

Few people know about vacation and travel opportunities available at college and university campuses. But academic institutions can provide inexpensive accommodations for the traveler.

There are 139 other inexpensive trips which can be planned that are listed in Mort's "Guide to Low-Cost Vacations & Lodgings on College Campuses." The guide describes facilities of 143 colleges in the U.S. and Canada which, in the past, have been enjoyed mostly by students but are now open to travelers.

In Michigan, colleges listed in the guide are Northern Michigan Univer-

sity in Marquette and Northwood Institute in Midland.

Available at most campuses, often under unrecorded conditions, are popular recreational activities such as swimming, golf, hiking, tennis, fishing and boating. The rates are low, usually only \$2 to \$4 a night for lodgings with meals on campus averaging 35 cents for breakfast, \$1.25 for lunch, and \$1.75 for dinner.

Activities listed in the guide include: water canoeing; trekking; scuba diving; soaring; mountain climbing; curling; spelunking; rock collecting; birdwatching; photography; native arts and crafts.

For sightseeing, campuses offer the unparalleled variety of all of America and Canada: city to wilderness; rodeo to Expo; historic restorations, flyways and waterways; mountains and canyons; amusement parks and national parks; caves and mines; and painted desert to primal forest.


Cultural activities include playhouses, festivals, ballet and bands, horticulture and history, lectures and classes, observatories and conservatories.

The guide makes it easier to plan trips and vacations at campuses in 41 states and five Canadian provinces, without tipping and parking fees but with an abundance of babysitters.
