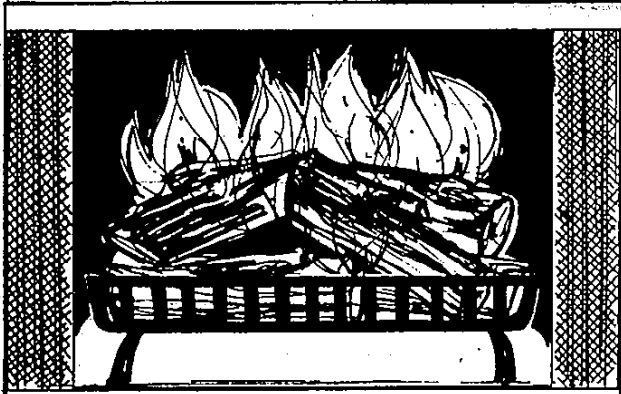

## Games for kids aid auto vacations

Most kids make good automobile travelers for the first 30 minutes. After that, it's downhill all the way. A little planning can prevent long trip headaches for parents and kids.

Babies and very young children are usually content with a few of their own soft toys. But for those of school age a ready fund of games is essential.

Most popular is the game of license plates. And with a few twists it can be a different game for each day. Try being the first to read the slogan on the plate, or add numbers on the plates to see who can get the highest score.

Try completing the entire alphabet from plate letter designations or select a surrounding state and see who can spot the most cars from that state.

A sneaky way to add a little learning in the fun is to give a prize to the youngster who can name the state capitol and the most facts about the state.

Mom or an older youngster can be the judge with the aid of a road atlas. Prizes can be getting to

choose the spot for lunch or dinner.

It's a camping trip, choice of dessert for the first night or freedom from a usually assigned chore, is a good prize.

Or the youngest member in the group can name a city, then the next youngest names a city whose name starts with the last letter of the one named.

If the first player chooses Lansing, then the next might say Grand Rapids. Choices can be limited to a state or any city in the country.

Players drop out as they are stumped leaving the last player the winner.

A tic-tac-toe pillow can serve as a head rest or a game. Cover a foam pillow with plain material stitched with game lines. Cut felt x's and o's and sew Velcro fasteners to the back of the pieces.

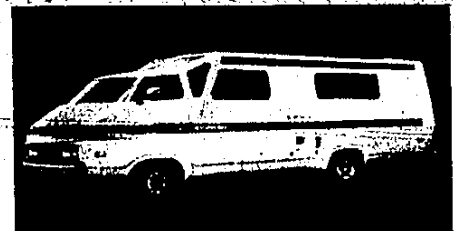
