Pastor attends writing school

Among the 206 writers and aspiring writers from Boston to Seattle who met for the recent 12th annual School for Christian Writers in Minneapolis was the Rev. Edward D. Auchard, pastor of the century-old Orchard Lake Community Church.

The school, sponsored by Decision magazine, seeks to increase confidence and competence of present and potential writers of evangelical material.

Mr. Auchard has written articles which have appeared in the United Presbyterian publication Monday Morning. He also published a book of sermons, The Path of Prayer, in 1963.

Director appointed

Rabbi Jeffrey B. Lazar, 29, has been appointed the new director of Religious Education at Temple Beth El.

Kirk sets guests

The Rev. Dr. John A. Redhead Jr., pastor emeritus of the First Presbyterian Church in Greensboro, N.C., will be the guest preacher at the Kirk in the Hills on Sunday.

Dr. Redhead, who will speak at both the 9:30 and 11:30 a.m. services, is a former National Radio Pulpit preacher for the National Council of Churches and has spoken for the Presbyterian series on the Protestant Hour for 13 years.

A native of Mississippi and a graduate of the Union Theological Seminary in Richmond, Va., he has served congregations in Virginia, Florida and North Carolina.

STARTING IN 1945, his Greensboro pastorate continued for 16

years until his retirement in 1970. The following year he received the Gold Medal award from Religious Heritage of America.

His denominational service included membership on the General Assembly's Committee on Union for six years, moderator of the Synod of North Carolina and trustee of Davidson College.

Dr. Redhead has published numerous religious articles, contributed to a wide variety of theological periodicals and his latest publication is "Finding Meaning in the Beatitudes."

He has been the commencement speaker on 35 campuses and will be making his first visit to the Gothic-styled Kirk in Bloomfield Hills.
