

MCF to test cervical cancer

The Michigan Cancer Foundation (MCF) has been awarded a million-dollat sub-contract by the Michigan Department of Public Health to conduct a three-year cervical cancer screening program in "high-risk" population areas of Wayne, Oakland and Macomb counties.

Goal is to provide free Pap tests for 25,000 women during the first year of service. First-year funding amounts to \$320,276.

Women considered to be "highrisks" include those who are medically under-serviced or medically
indigent. Women who are reluctant or unable to obtain medicalcheckups and periodic Pap tests often are in lower socio-economic
groups. The incidence of cervical
cancer is highest in these groups.

QUALIFIED health care personnel will do the screening. Laboratory work will be performed at MCF's Meyer L. Prentis Cancer Center headquarters in Detroit and at other facilities with laboratories licensed by the department of health.

Women who have positive tests Women who have positive tests (indicating pre-cancerous cells or presence of cancer) will be referred to physicians designated ty the women themselves, or to out-patient community hospitals departments and to local health centers

which will be cooperating in the cancer detection effort.

A Torch Drive-United Way agency, the Michigan Cancer Foundation was selected to administer the screening efforts because of its efforts in cancer research, detection, clinical investigation, patient services and rehabilitation, and public health, education.

FUNDS for the sub-contract were issued through the National Cancer Institute, an agency of the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

"We know if we can detect cervical cancer early and if treatment is immediately initiated we can save lives," said Dr. Michael J. Brennan, MCF president.

"Our goal is to reduce the cervical cancer death rate by more than 50 percent over a 10-year period," he said.

PLANNING for the new service already is under way and cervical screening could begin as early as August.

Cervical cancer is the most common type of uterine cancer, which causes an estimated 450 deaths avear in Michigan.

Approximately half of the state's population is in the tricounty area where the newlyfunded service will be concentrated.
