

Church celebrates centennial

The Orchard Lake Community Church will celebrate the centennial of the original Orchard Lake Chapel on Sunday and Thursday (July 18).

An historical marker authorized by the State Historical Commission will be dedicated at 2:30 p.m. Sunday. The original chapel was dedicated on July 18, 1874.

The Rev. Donald Lester, executive for the Presbytery of Detroit, will preach at the 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. services Sunday.

HUDSON MEAD of Grosse Pointe, a member of the Michigan Historical Commission, will present the marker.

Larry Dailey, clerk of the session of the Orchard Lake Church, will accept the marker; Mel Rycus, mayor of Orchard Lake, and Gen. Frederick Strong will respond with brief remarks.

The dedicatory address will be given by Rabbi Israel Halpern of Congregation Beth Abraham Hill in West Bloomfield Township.

The Rev. Edward D. Auchard, pastor of the Orchard Lake Church since 1957, will offer the dedicatory prayer.

ON THURSDAY (July 13), the church is sponsoring an old-fashioned ice cream social at 6:30 p.m. on the church lawn followed by open house at the 100-year-old manse next door, concluding with a vesper service on the shores of Orchard Lake.

Cameron McLean, 91-year-old baritone, will sing. Music also will

be presented by The Spirit of 66 (Psalm 66), an ensemble of young people from the Orchard Lake Church.

The congregation will join in singing old songs and Mr. Auchard will present a brief meditation. An evening of memories, featur-

ing motion pictures from past years and informal recollections of the church's past, will be offered at 7:30 p.m. Saturday.

Dr. Irvine to speak

The Rev. Dr. Frank J. Irvine, assistant pastor at the Kirk in the Hills, will speak at both the 9:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. services at the Bloomfield Hills church on Sunday. His sermon title will be "Deliver the Goods."

After the death of the Kirk's long-time minister, the Rev. Dr. Harold C. DeWindt, in April 1971, Dr. Irvine was named interim assistant minister for pastoral care and administration while a special committee searched for a new senior pastor.

The Rev. Dr. James F. Anderson was selected as senior pastor and installed on April 30, 1972, and Dr. Irvine was subsequently named assistant pastor.

BEFORE COMING to the Kirk, Dr. Irvine served as pastor of the Warren Avenue Presbyterian

Church in Saginaw for eight years. Prior to that he was pastor of the Cherry Hill Presbyterian Church in Dearborn during its growth from a small congregation with no edifice to a large group worshipping in the present colonial sanctuary.

A native of Iowa, Dr. Irvine was graduated from Pittsburgh-Xenia Theological Seminary and Sterling College in Kansas. He is a member of the theological education committee of the Detroit Presbytery and also served as chairman of the nominating committee of the synod and was a member of its planning department.

In 1960, Dr. Irvine was named moderator of the Detroit Presbytery. He also served for four years on a permanent judicial commission with the general assembly.
