University modern dance, a new department at the National Music Camp, will present its first concert at 8 p.m. Friday, at Interlochen.

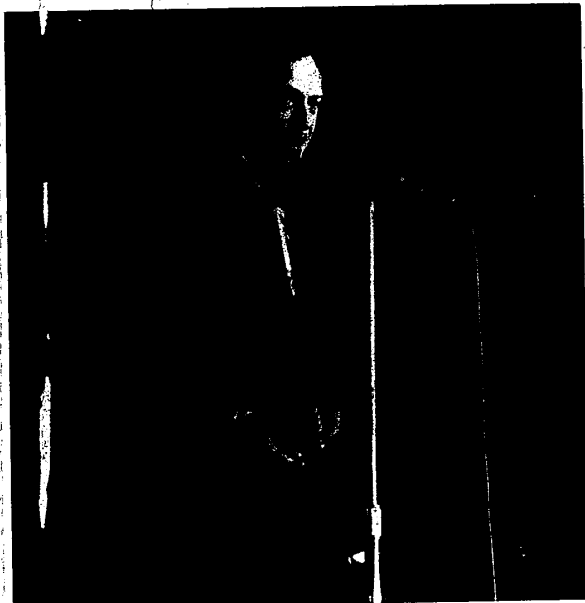
Eight university dance majors are on the program: Jane Acton, Deborah Baker, Susan Blum of Southfield, Barbara Canner of Southfield, Robert Handler of Oak Park, Mary Matthaei of Bloomfield Hills, Michael Quintance and Lisa Schartow.

The department's two teaching assistants, John Cwiakala and Carol Richard, will premiere choreographic works.

Ms. Richard's "Dumb Dances" will include 10 dancers with accompaniment by percussionist Bill Moersch.

CWIAKALA'S "Brewed" is for a quintet—himself, Ms. Richard and department head Gay DeLanghe with Lauren Wagner and Bernadine Oakley of the camp's university opera theater, who will perform onstage with vocal improvisations.

The university dance company will perform parts of "Limblateral or Arm Technology vs. Leg Technology," choreographed by Ms. DeLanghe. The work was commissioned by the National Endowment for the Arts in 1972 and was done in New York.

Chet Atkins, Boots Randolph and Floyd Cramer with the Boots Randolph Orchestra and the Music City Sound of Strings are the Masters Festival of Music appearing at Pine Knob Music Theatre at 7:30 p.m. Sunday.

Originating in Nashville, the show runs the gamut from swinging country, to semioperate, to the Battle Hymn of the Republic.

Chet Atkins is known as Mr. Guitar and the "Young Grand-Old-Man of the Pop Guitar." He has appeared with the Boston Pops and the Atlanta, Nashville, Memphis, Seattle, Pittsburgh and St. Louis Symphonies.

Mr. Saks, Boots Randolph, actually started out on the ukelele, switched to the trombone and finally came upon the instrument he is known for.

Floyd Cramer's piano style is described as lonesome, cool and melancholy.



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
