Adat Shalom salutes Rabbi's anniversary

A dinner tribute will be celebrated at Adat Shalom on Sunday evening, Sept. 8, in honor of Rabbi Jacob E. Segal who has completed 35 years of service in the American rabbinate.

Rabbi Segal came to Adat Shalom in 1946. Since then, due to his inspiration, about 12 young men and women, all members of the synagogue, have undertaken professional Jewish leadership careers as rabbis and educators.

He is one of the founders of the Hill-El Day School of Detroit. His congregation credits "his remarkable calls for action on the Holy Days" as a factor in the congregation becoming one of the leaders in the Israel Bond enterprise.

THE JEWISH Theological Seminary, where he was ordained as rabbi in 1939, awarded him an honorary degree of Doctor of Divinity three years ago in recognition of his achievements.

Co-chairmen for the celebration are Samuel Frankel and Sol Eisenberg, who are working with associate chairmen Samuel Hechtman, David Polack and Robert Ruch.

The evening's events will begin with cocktails at 6 p.m. and dinner is scheduled to be served at 7 p.m. in the synagogue's social hall.
