

DSYO tryouts planned

The last of the preliminary auditions for all sections of the Detroit Symphony Youth Orchestra (DSYO) will be held Aug. 23 and 24 at Ford Auditorium.

Viola, cello, and bass players are particularly welcome; any talented young musician living in the Detroit metropolitan area is eligible for membership provided he or she does not drop out of school band or orchestra activities in order to seek or maintain membership in the DSYO.

Applicants will be asked to perform a solo composition of their own choosing and to sightread some representative orchestral excerpts. All players in the final auditions, to be scheduled in September, must have played a preliminary audition.

In addition to the regular DSYO rehearsals, held on Saturday afternoons from late September through April, sectional rehearsals are held under the guidance of

members of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra (DSO), whose coaching and assistance of these young musicians has been an important contribution to the general development of the youth orchestra.

The DSYO has a limited number of scholarships, awarded on the basis of talent and need, to study privately with DSO players.
